- 1. Pursuant to Rule 116 of the UCPR, personal service of this Originating Application on the Member Respondents be dispensed with.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 116 of the UCPR, in lieu of personal service of the Originating Application on the Member Respondents, service be effected by the Applicant, whether by himself or by his employees or agents howsoever:
 - (a) sending a copy of the Originating Application, the affidavit material in support the application and explanatory statement substantially (in the form in which is exhibit AJT-3 to the affidavit of Ashley John Tiplady sworn on 17 March 2023 (the Explanatory Statement)) to each Member Respondent where an email address or postal address is known by the Applicant by:
 - email, whether as an attachment or series of attachments, or by posting a hyperlink within the email to a location at which those documents may be downloaded or accessed electronically; or
 - (ii) ordinary pre-paid post;

to the Member Address; and

- (b) by publishing on the Website, the Originating Application, the supporting affidavit material and the Explanatory Statement, and having those documents available for download until final orders are made in this proceeding or the Applicant ceases to have control of the Website (whichever occurs first);

 - (i) 14 April 2023; or
 - (ii) 14 days after the Respondent is served.
 - (b) The Applicant file and serve:
 - (i) written submissions on which it relies for the Application; and
 - (ii) any affidavit relied upon as to service,

on any Respondent who has filed a notice of address for service, by 21 April 2023.

- (c) any Respondent who has filed a notice of address for service and affidavit under Paragraph 7(a) of this Order must file and serve on the Applicant written submissions on which the Respondent relies for the originating application by 28 April 2022;
- 8. The application be listed for hearing in the Applications List on 2 May 2023, for 1.5 hours.
- 9. The parties have liberty to apply on three business days' notice in writing.
- 10. The Applicant's costs be costs in the proceeding.
